

Transfer / Roll Layout Guide

- Looking at the image through the paper (ink side down)
- Eyemarks used by machines to control the advance of the roll are typically halfway between repeats
- Typical spacing is 1 image every 2" to 5", spacing varies due to size, volume, and machine requirements.

Please advise minimum spacing ______ " from the end of one image to the start of the next.

Note: Eyemarks will be printed with same ink as the image and must not be pressed with heated platen.
